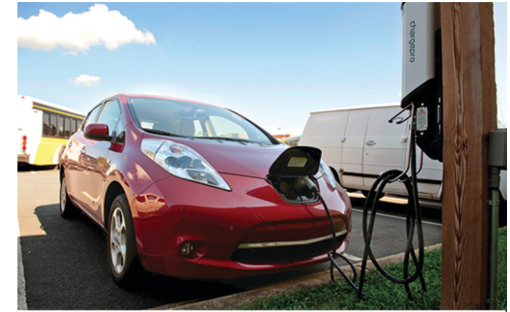


UMBC SUSTAINABILITY
