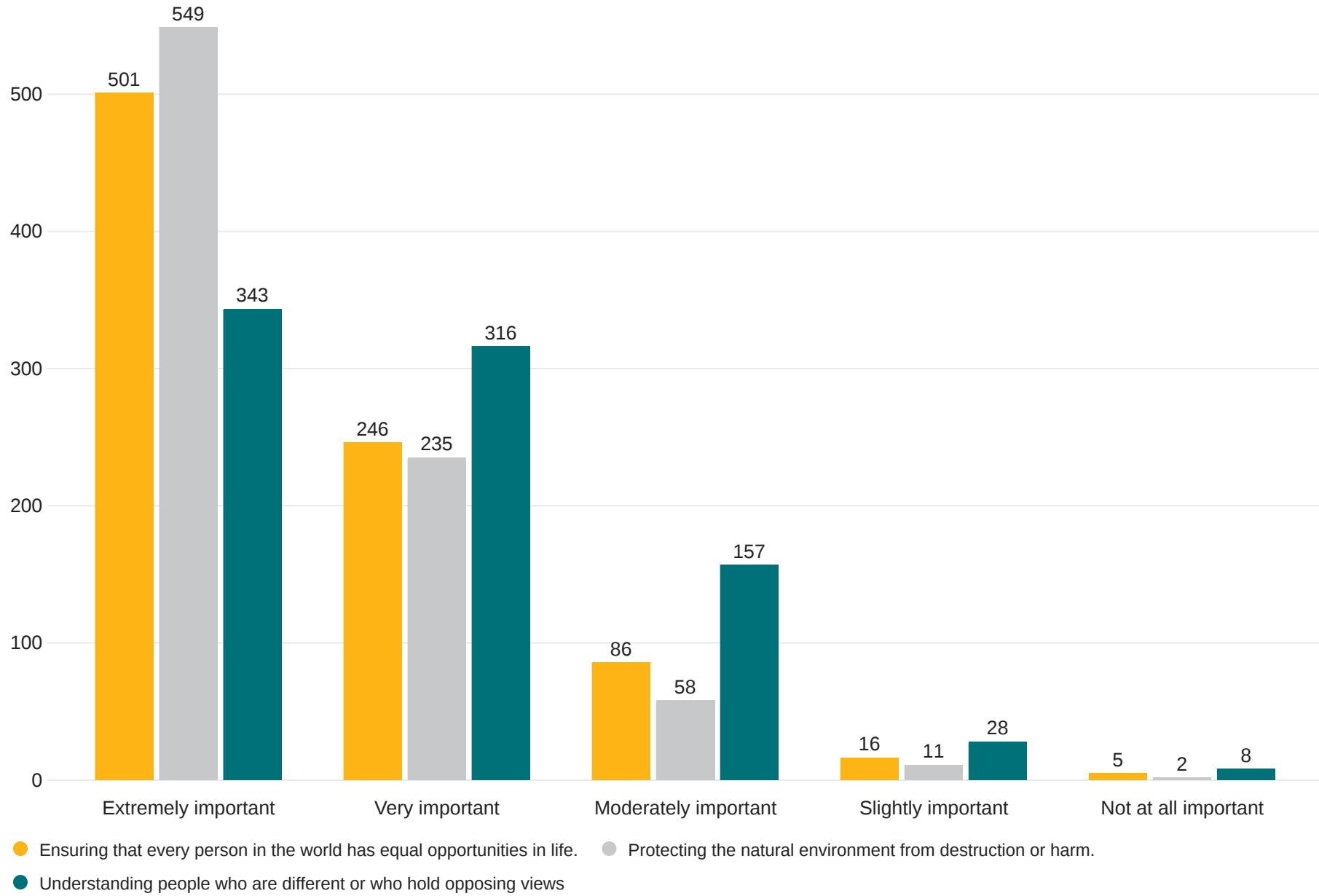

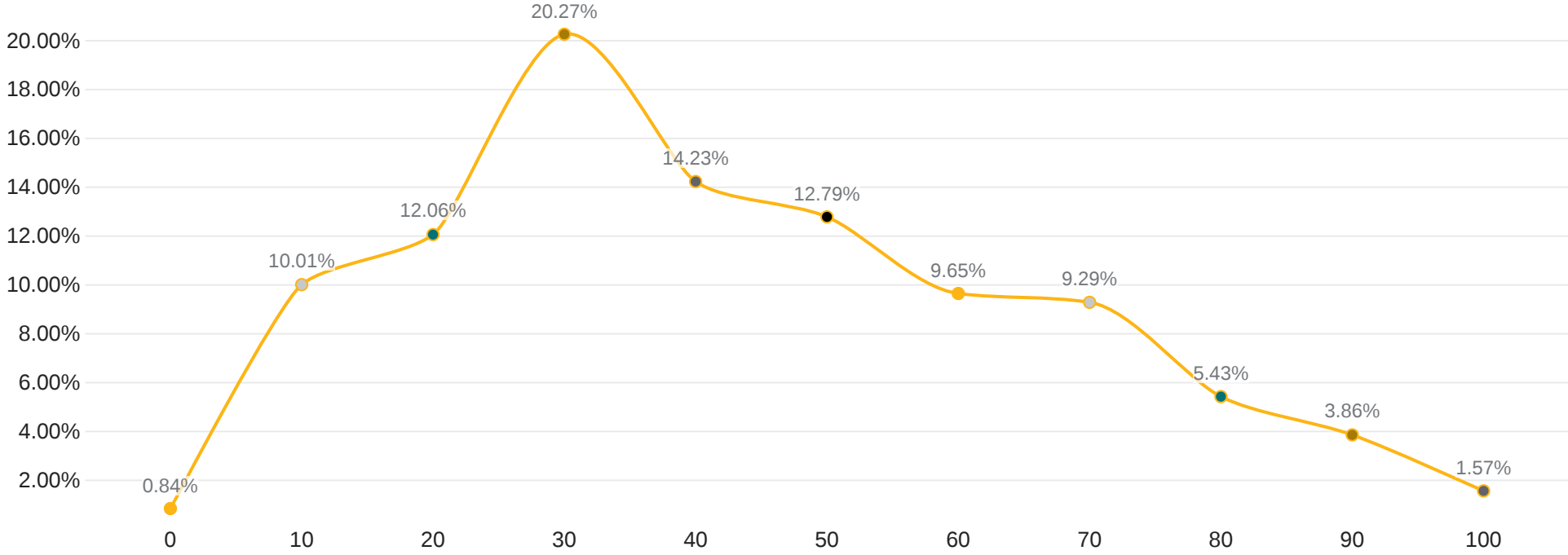

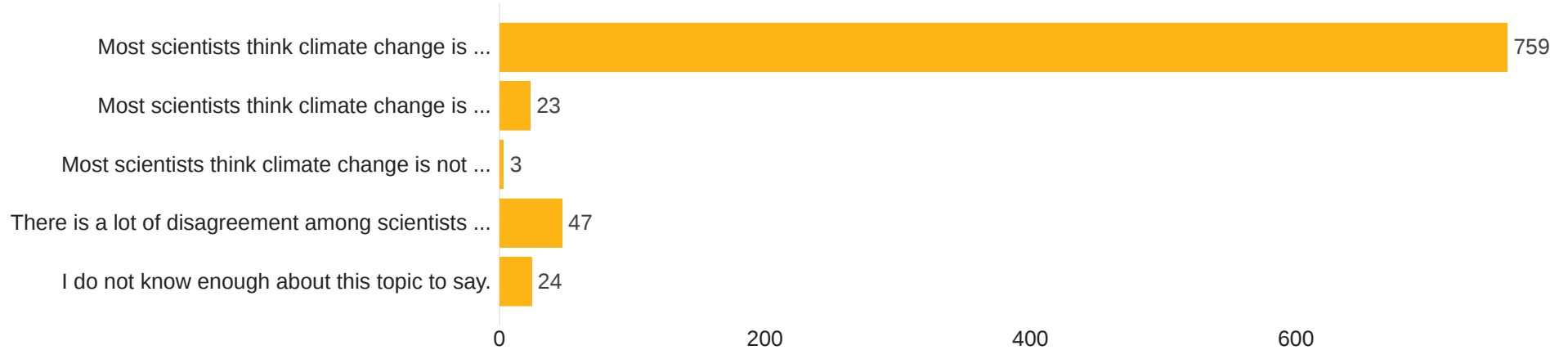

CA-3_1 - Percentage of Sustainable Food Purchases



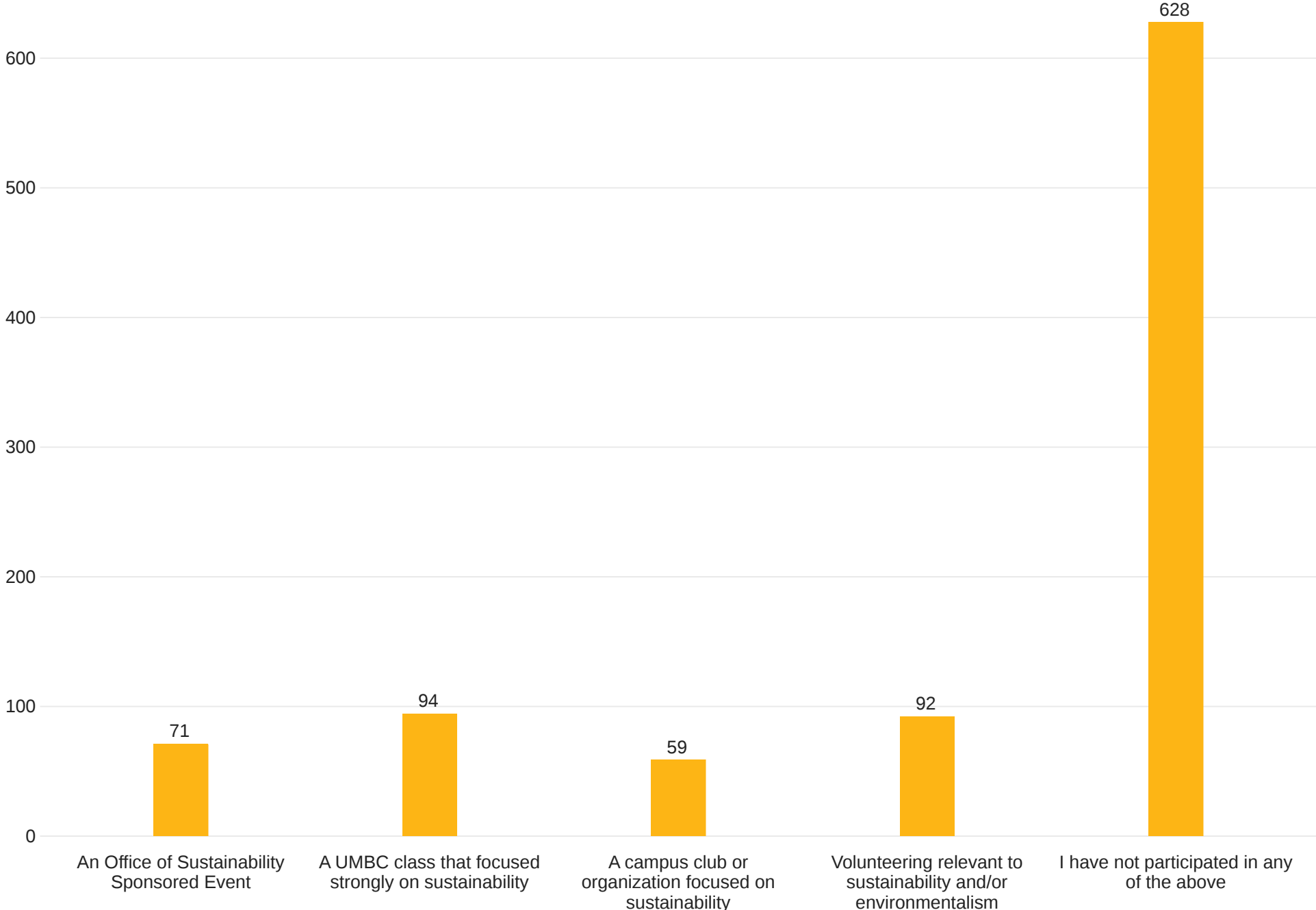

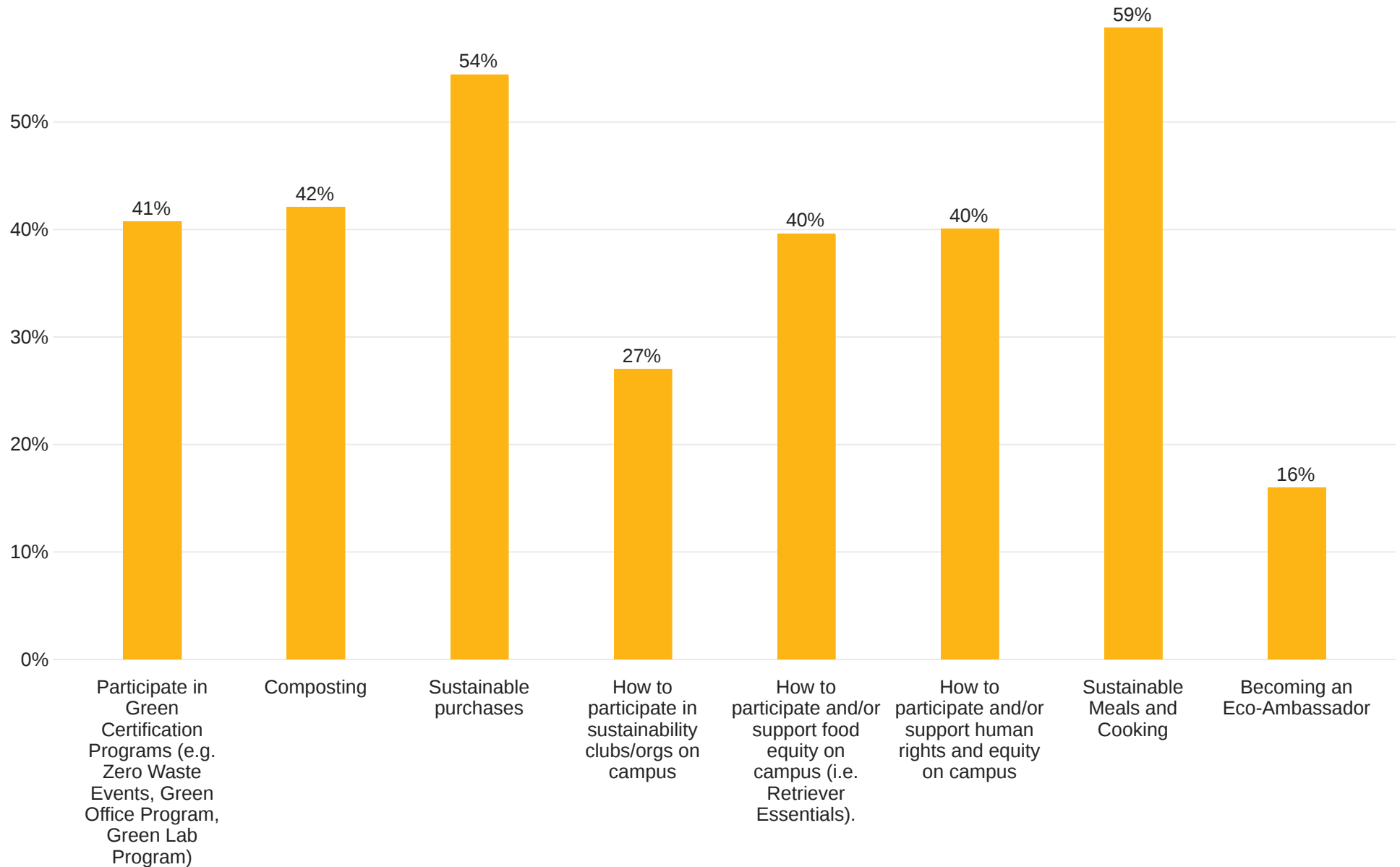

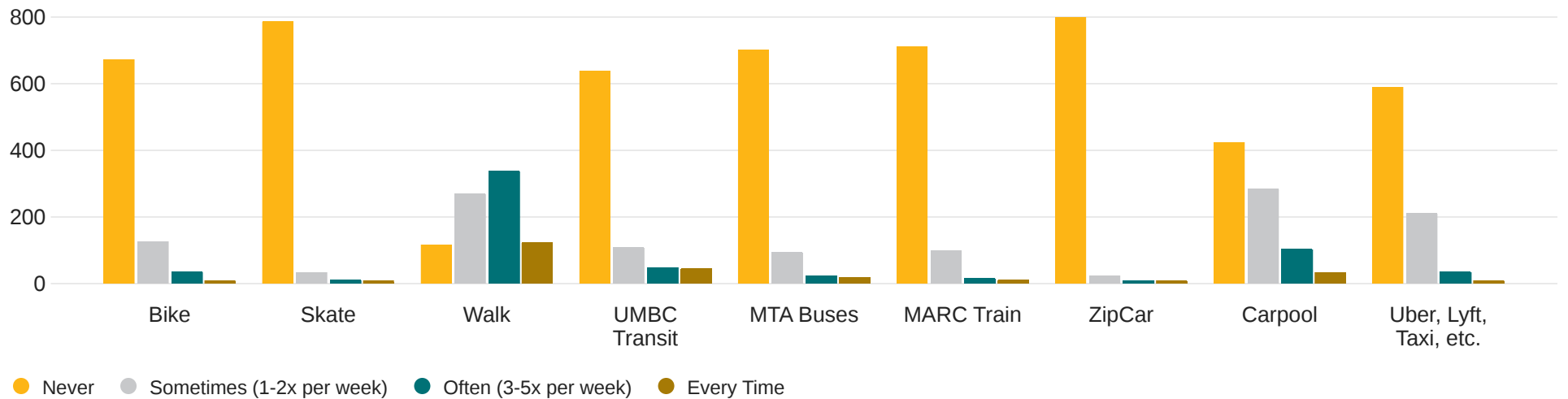

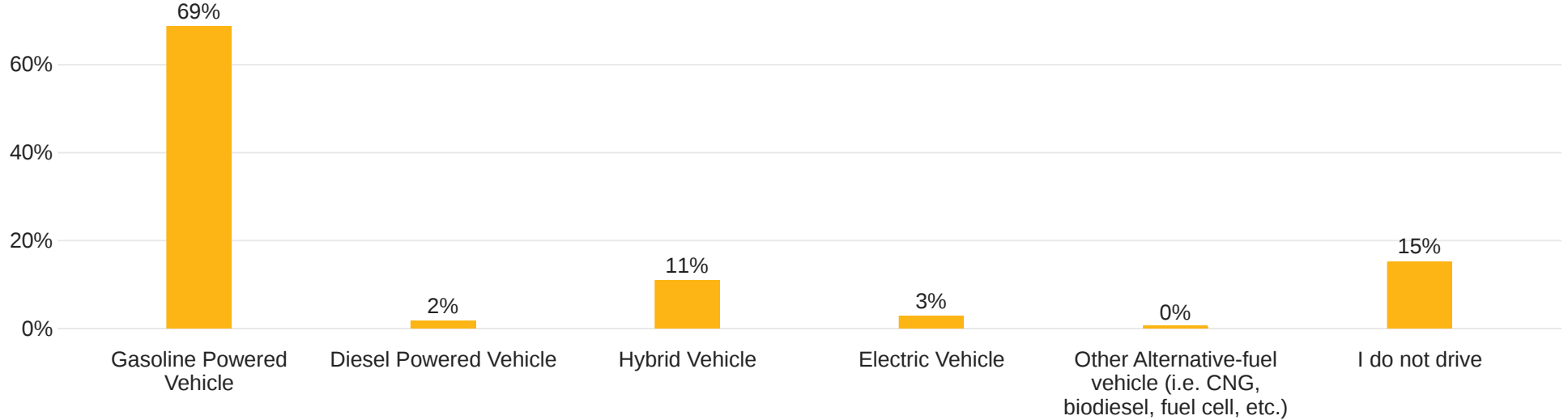

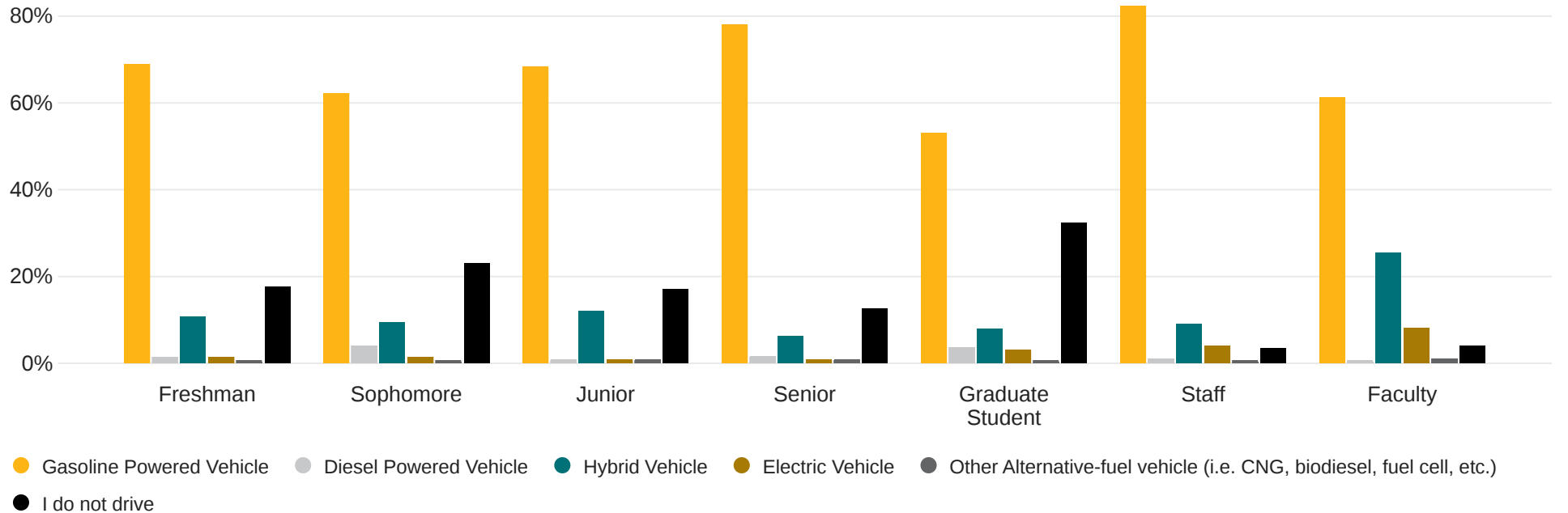

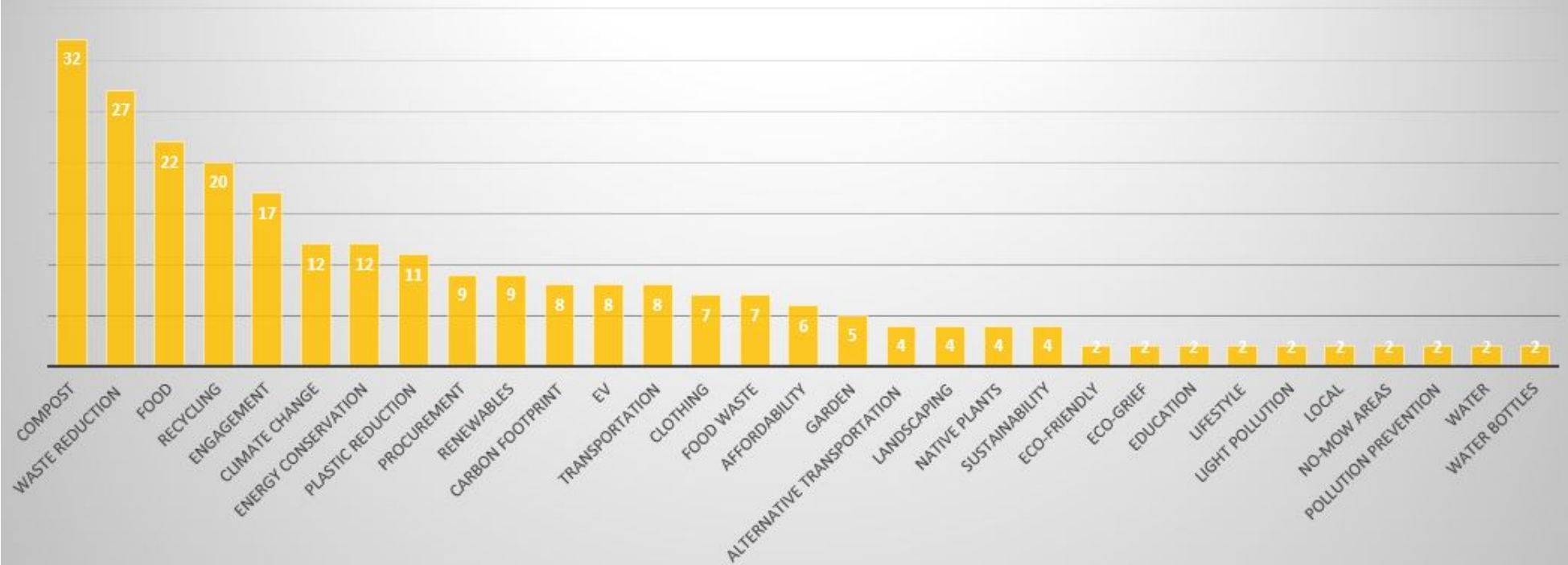

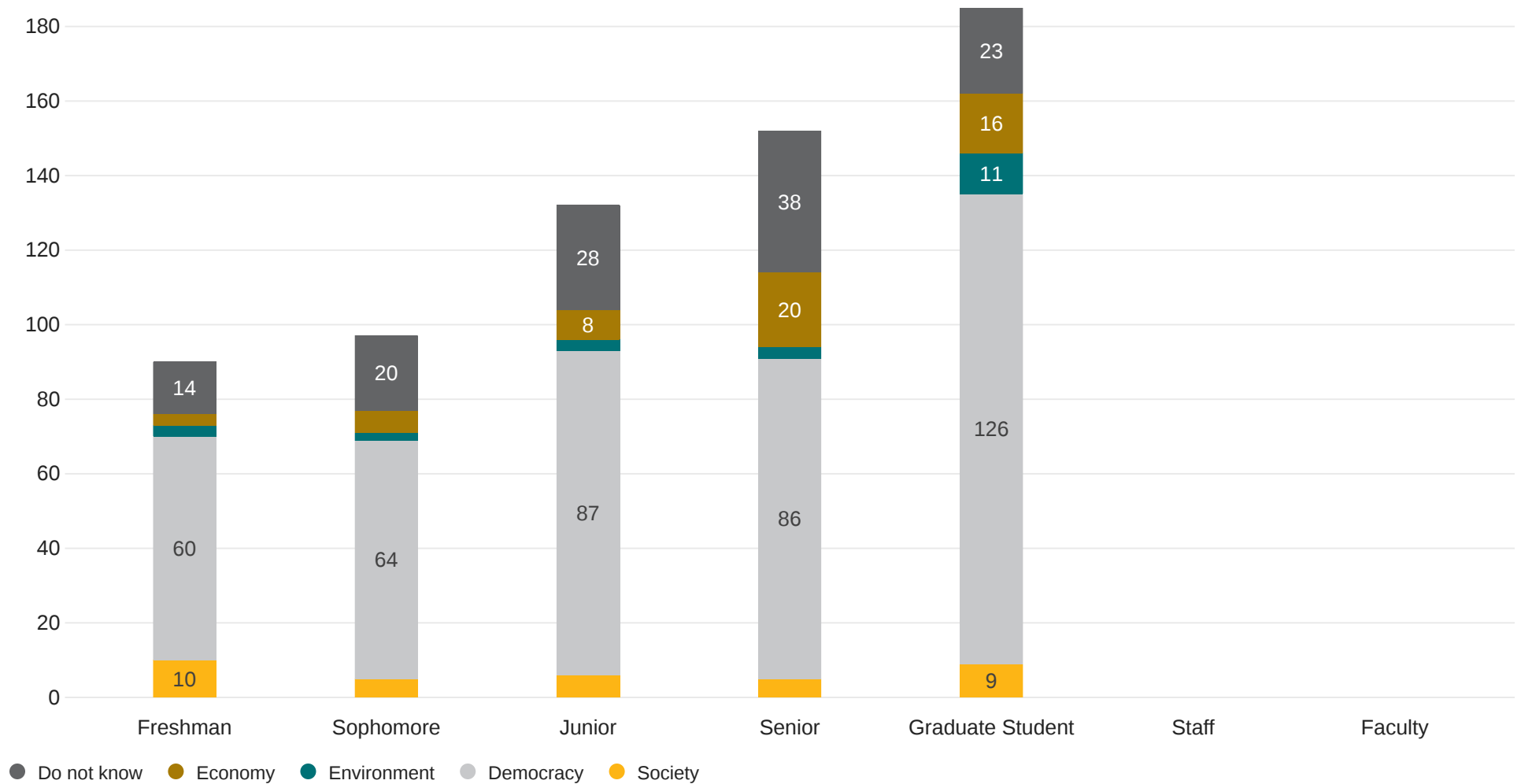

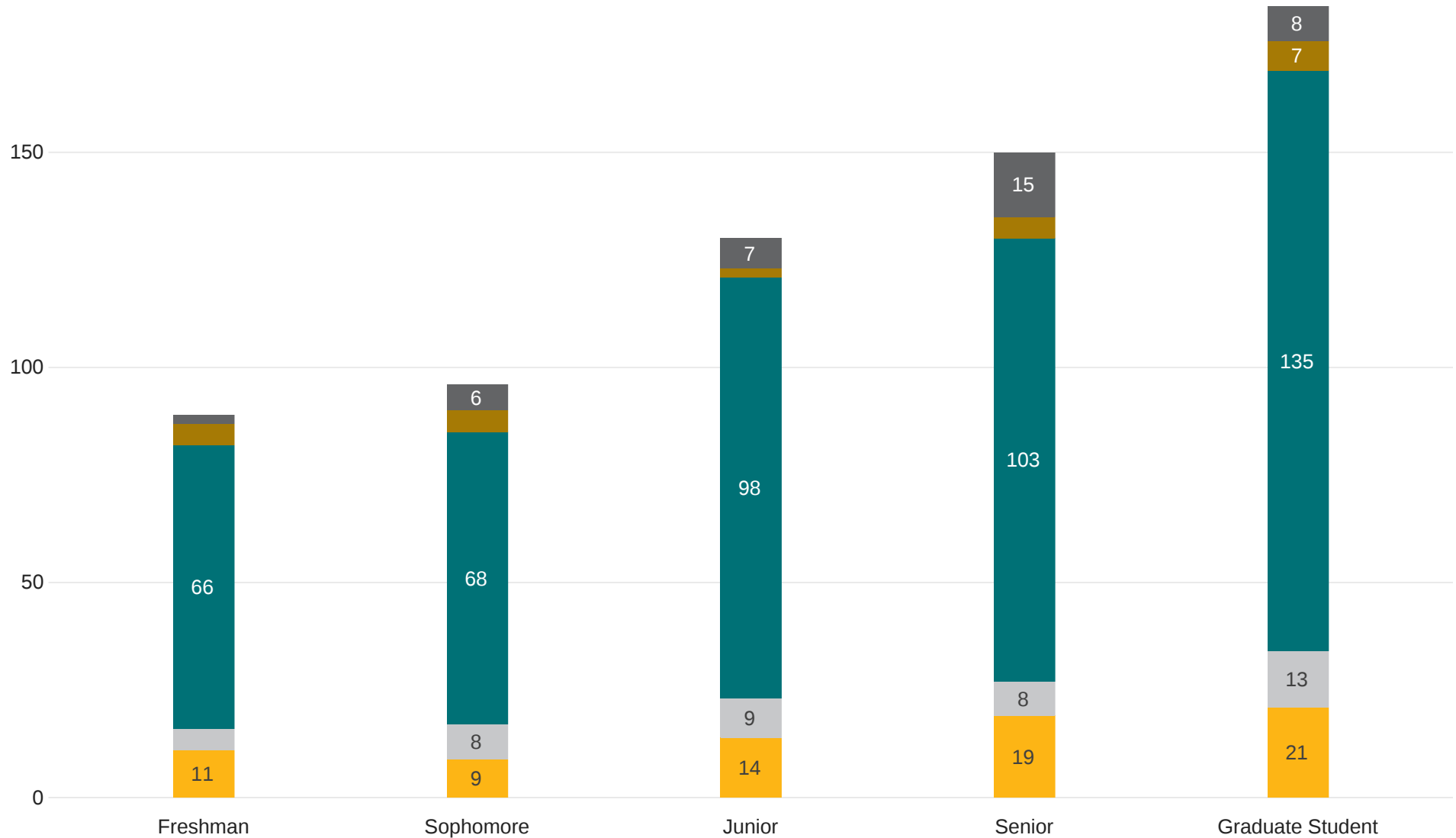

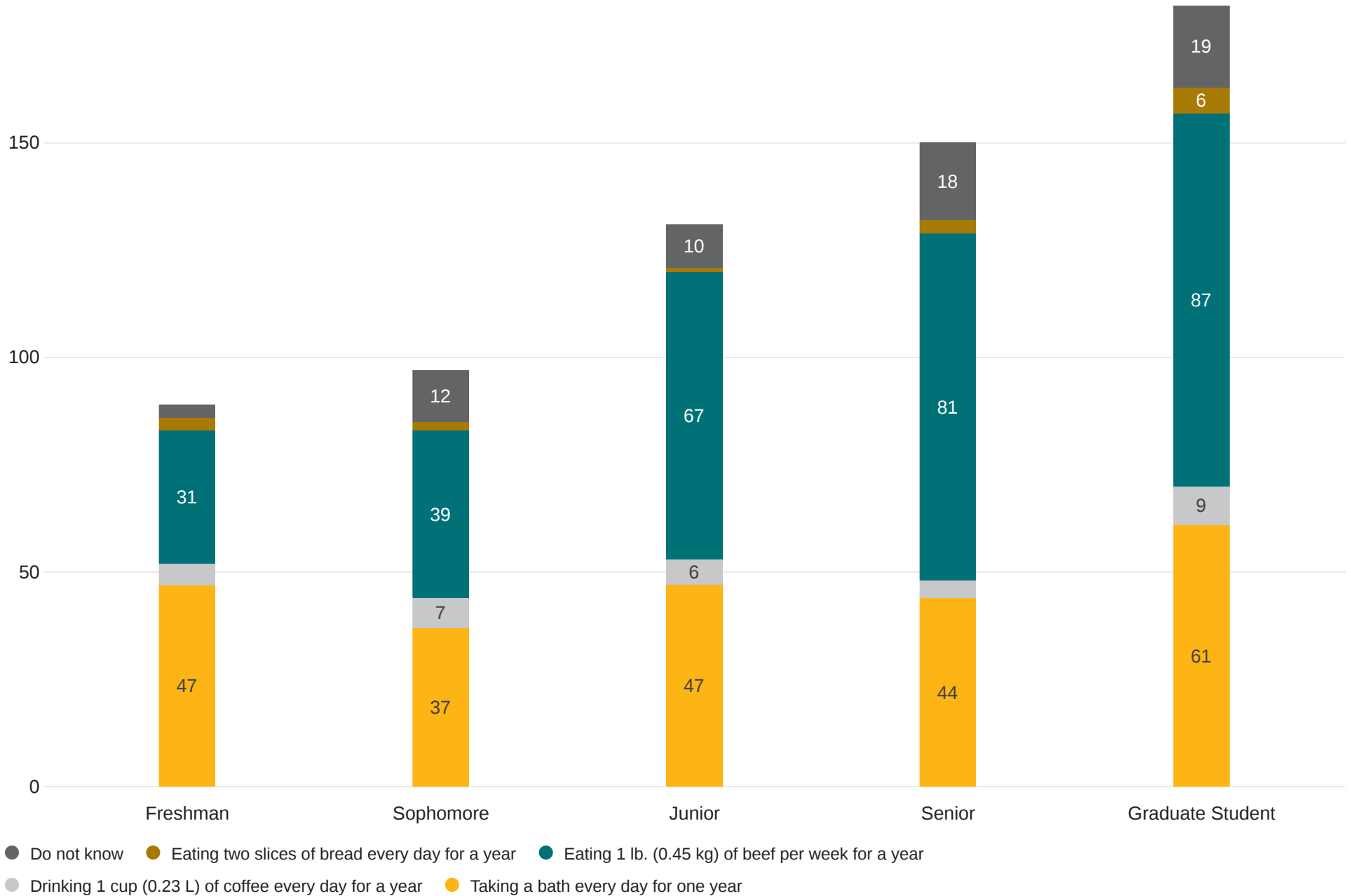

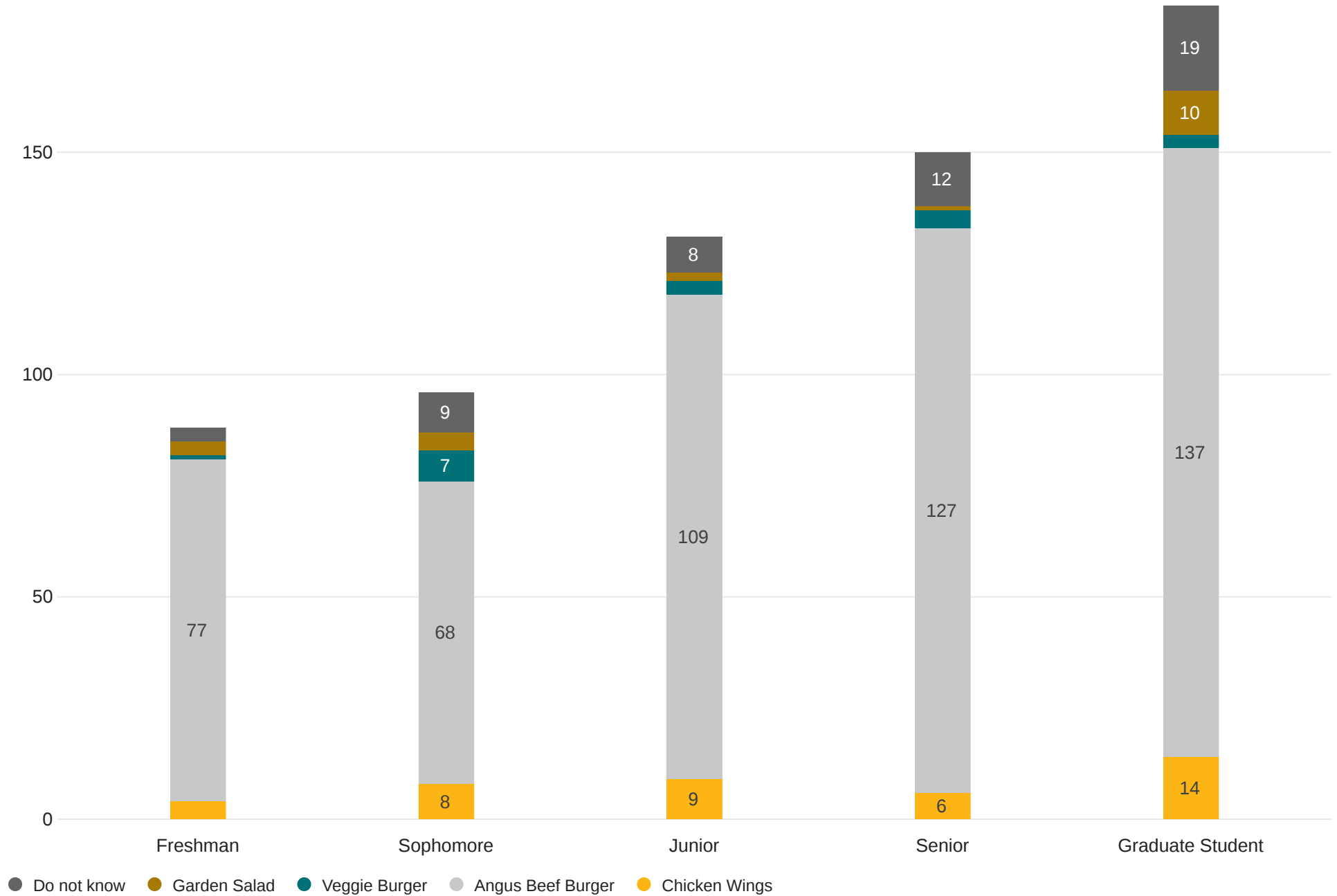
LA-5 - Which source of energy produces the most greenhouse gas emissions?



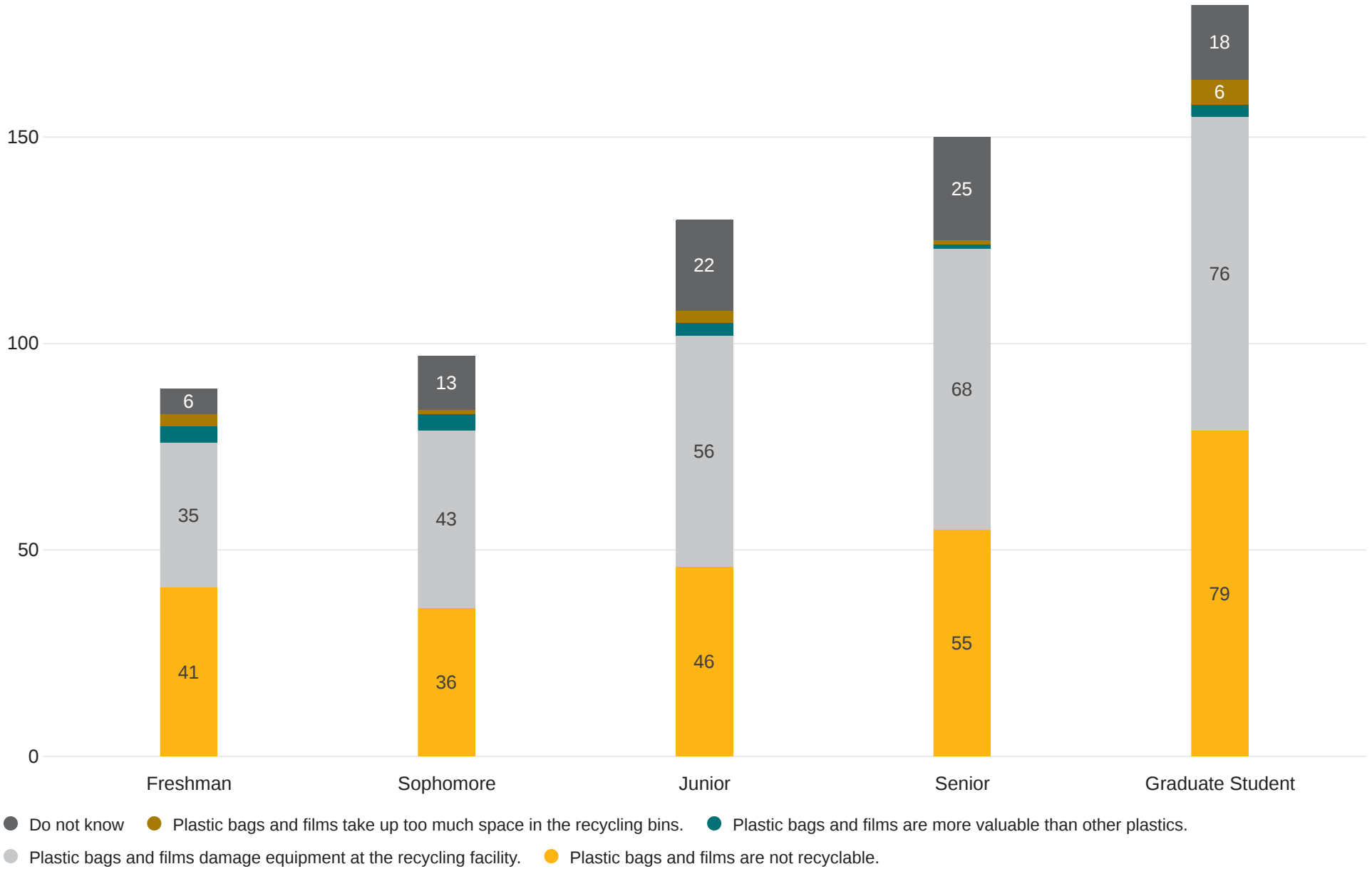

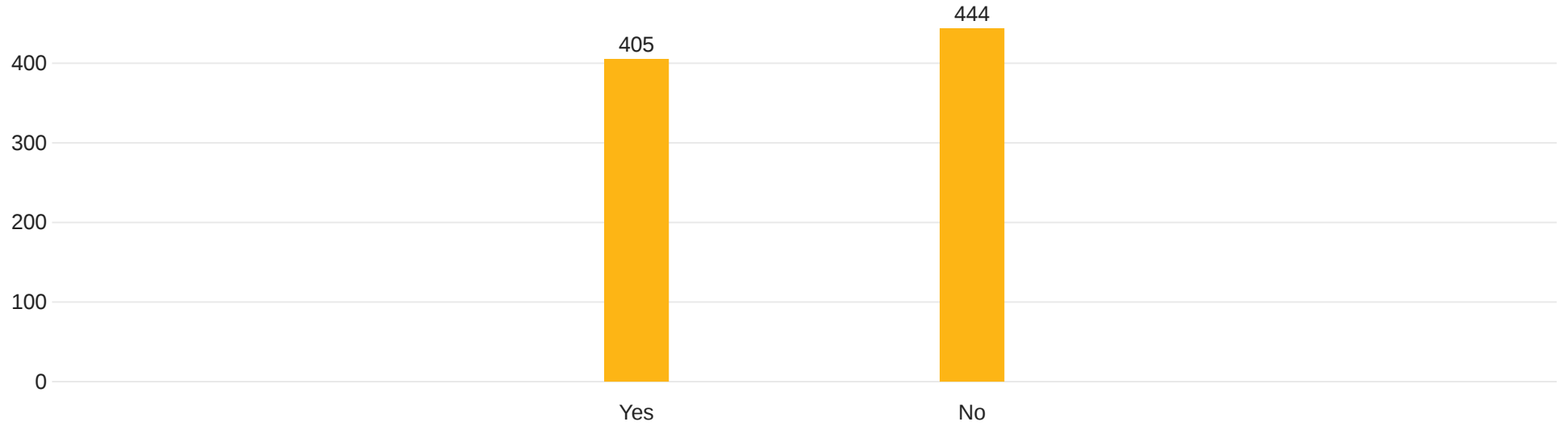
